



# CLOTHING SWAP!



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*"Promotion of joy and fun in dealing with sustainable clothing.*

*In the course of a clothing swap party, items of clothing are brought along and put into a pool, and items of clothing can be taken back from this clothing pool.*

*It's free and is meant to raise awareness about recycling old items.*

*This can happen on a small scale, but also with several people (5 - 50 people)"*

## WHAT YOU NEED

Clothes rails, hangers, tables to put clothes on, stamps, cards, people sorting clothes.

## STEP FOR REALIZATION

1. Collect the clothes from different people and the young people.
2. Sort the clothes and hang/put them up.
3. Each person who wants to participate in the clothing exchange first comes to the check-in and is allowed to show their clothes. Someone should check if the clothes are still intact or clean. It is advisable to set a maximum number of garments beforehand.
4. Each person who participates in the clothes swap gets as many stamps as the number of clothes he or she has brought.
5. Then "new" clothes may be chosen, but only as many as the person has stamps.
6. Before the person leaves again, the clothes and stamp cards are checked.

## HOW WOULD YOU PROMOTE IT?

This activity is very easy to promote and is also becoming more and more modern. It is possible to make a clothes swap only two, but it is recommended to involve at least 5 people.



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
